The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has reviewed the September 8, 2017 report entitled "2017 Semiannual Monitoring Data Transmittal", prepared on your behalf by CH2M Engineers, Inc. After careful review, the TCEQ accepts the report and notes the following.

Sampling results indicate that 1,1-dichloroethene, tetrachloroethene, and trichloroethene were reported above the critical protective concentration levels (cPCLs) at several monitoring well locations (MW-74, MW-93R, MW-97, MW-160, and MW-168) throughout the groundwater plume. In addition, grab samples collected from the Harris County Flood Control District Ditch resulted identified no analysis results reported above the cPCL. The reported concentrations remain historically consistent and no new notifications were required based on the June 8, 2017 sampling event. The next sampling event is scheduled for December 2017.
