The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has reviewed the above mentioned document dated September 18, 2015, and concurs with its contents. The document states that the contamination plume continues to be affected (both on and off-site) by the Texas Department of Transportation's (TxDOT) dewatering system at the I-610/I-10 interchange. The TxDOT system impacts property along the eastern boundary of the VCP property the most. Please continue with the groundwater monitoring program as written in the Response Action Plan (RAP), paying close attention to any changes in the plume and notifying property owners as necessary.
