The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has reviewed the July 14, 2015 report entitled *2014 Annual Ground Water Monitoring Report and Field Activities Summary*. The TCEQ understands that the plume is still being affected by the I10/610 dewatering system along the eastern boundary of the property. Groundwater concentrations are generally decreasing or remaining stable; however, concentrations remain above protective concentration levels for some constituents. Please continue with your sampling efforts and evaluating plume stability as stated in the August 29, 2003 approved Response Action Plan (RAP). Please forward results to my attention.
