The VCP of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has reviewed the above mentioned document dated August 13, 2014. The VCP understands that the plume is still being affected by the I10/610 dewatering system along the eastern boundary of the property. Groundwater concentrations are generally decreasing, however concentrations remain above protective concentration levels for some constituents. Please continue with your sampling efforts checking for plume expansion as stated in the August 29, 2003 approved Response Action Plan (RAP). Forward any results to my attention.
