Dear Mr. Fasting:

The VCP of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has reviewed the above referenced submittal. Based on the requirements of the October 25, 2004 and December 30, 2004 TCEQ letters concerning the method that will be used to determine when more frequent monitoring or remedial response actions will be required, the TCEQ has the following comments. No response to these comments is required.


1. The TCEQ agrees with the continued quarterly monitoring of chemical of concern (COC) concentrations in groundwater at monitoring wells MW-70, MW-78, MW-93, MW-96 and MW-125 as the remedial response action.
2. The TCEQ also agrees with the evaluation of the presence of permanganate in monitoring/injection wells (MW-150 through MW-155 and IW-47 through IW-52) from prior injection events in the area of MW-78, MW-93 and MW-125. If no permanganate is present and the COC concentrations at MW-78, MW-93 and MW125 exceed the groundwater protective concentration levels (PCLs), additional permanganate injections should be conducted.
3. The TCEQ acknowledges that the affected groundwater downgradient of monitoring well MW-96 will be delineated, and that drilling activities should be completed by November 15, 2007.

4. The next quarterly sampling event will be conducted in January 2008 because a regularly scheduled semiannual event was to be conducted in October 2007.
